

the area in which all goods traffic takes place








Airport terminal

Employees Brussels Airport: some figures

- Flemish region: 73,9%
 - 40,2% Flemish-Brabant mostly in the vicinity of the airport (municipalities of Zaventem,
 Vilvoorde, but also Machelen, Steenokkerzeel, Kortenberg, Kampenhout and Leuven)
 - 17,3% from Antwerp
 - 9,7% from East-Flanders
 - 4,1% Limburg
 - o 2,7% West-Flanders
- Brussels Capital region: 15,7%

Walloon region 10,4%





- French or Dutch


















Maintenance & Repair





Step 2: Training

A. Training



- Professional training for logistics employees (via partners)
 - Training logistics employee transport (VDAB)
 - Dispatcher (VDAB)
 - Logistics Coordinator (VDAB)
 - Fret Aérien employee (Le Forem)
 - Export manager (Dorifor)
 - Import Export Officer (Dorifor)
 - Agent d'entrepôt aéroportuaire (le Forem)
 - Short training courses in cooperation with the temporary employment sector
- Security guard training (VDAB/Brufor)
 - Recruitment commitment security company (condition for starting up)
- Customs declarant training
 - Via Brufor/Le Forem





A. Training

- Online training
 - Air freight logistics (VDAB)
 - Excel (different parts)
 - Customs introduction (VDAB)
 - Logistics Customs: Formalities and documents (VDAB)
- Improve general digital skills
 - via VDAB/Actiris/Le Forem/ADG





B. IBO at Brussels Airport

WHAT?

- Individual professional training
- Min 1 month max 6 months
- Learning the tricks of the job and gaining the necessary experience
- Contract between you, VDAB and employer
- Payment = benefit plus IBO premium (plus compensation for travel and childcare)

Conditions:

- Registered as a jobseeker with VDAB
- Did not quit your previous job to start an IBO
- Have not yet worked for the company where you are going to do an IBO







- AFTER IBO (completed successfully)
 - Fixed or indefinite contract
- What the job seeker has to do
 - Mention on CV & in interview with employer
- Employer questions about IBO
 - Refer to Aviato
