Employment Service of Slovenia is one of the key Slovenian labour market institutions.

It is an independent legal entity with public institute status operating uniformly across the entire country.

Main ESS activities:

- employment advice and job consulting
- life-long career guidance
- unemployment benefit and unemployment insurance
- implementation of active employment policy (AEP) measures and programs
- issuing of work and employment permits for foreign workers
- preparation of analytical, development and other professional materials related to ESS activities
- labor market (LM) and ESS information of a public nature



Users of ESS services are:

- unemployed persons,
- employers,
- jobseekers, pupils and students who need professional help in the fields of employment and career guidance,
- professional institutions,
- providers of active employment policy programs,
- social partners and
- general public.

HOW TO START 

JOBSEEKERS

The right to free access to the labor market means that foreigners in the Republic of Slovenia can get employment or self-employment without a permit for work.

HOW TO START

- Citizens of **EU member states** (old and new) and **EEA** (Norway, Liechtenstein, Iceland) and **Switzerland** are equal in job seeking and getting employment with the Slovenian workers.
 - This means that in case they get employment they do not need a permit for work.
 - Citizens from **EU or EEA Member States and Switzerland do not require a permit** for work in Slovenia.



Career centre

Career center is a place where you can find information you need when planning your education or employment.

You can get correct information to help you decide your career path.




The following information is available for you:

- description of vocations,
- information on (upper)secondary and higher education institutions,
- information on possibilities for vocational training and study abroad,
- information on available financial aids for education and training,
- postings of educational programs,
- information on student residences,
- postings of jobs,
- directions and tools for more effective job searching,
- video clips of vocations,
- computer programs for independent planning of educational or vocational path.

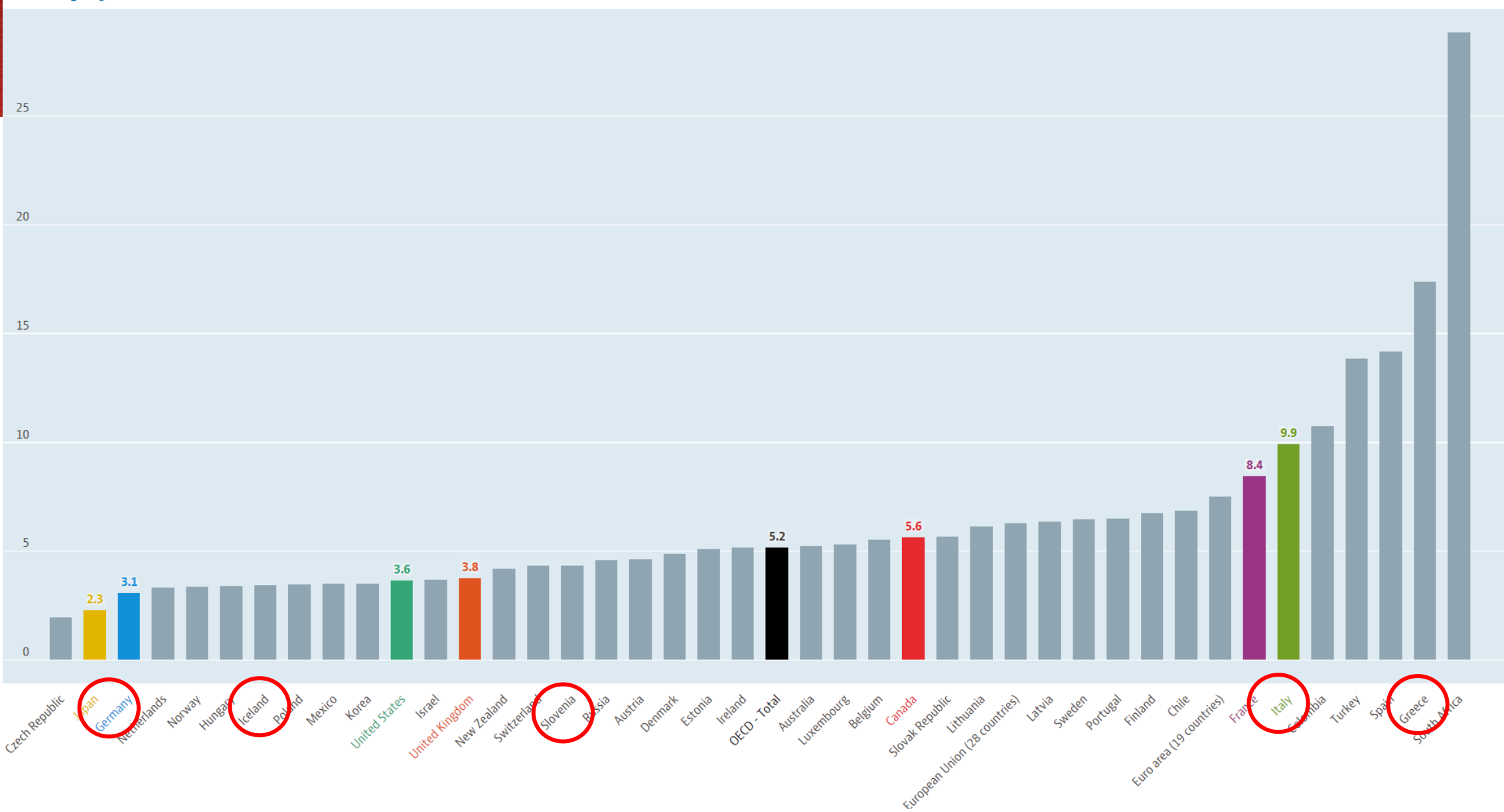
UNEMPLOYMENT AND YOUNG PEOPLE

- 621 million young people aged 15-24 years old are not in education, employment or training
- 75 million young people are trained but have no job.
- In the next decade, one billion young people will enter the labor market, and large numbers of young people face a future of irregular and informal employment.
- Almost 90% of all young people live in developing countries.

UNEMPLOYMENT AND YOUNG PEOPLE

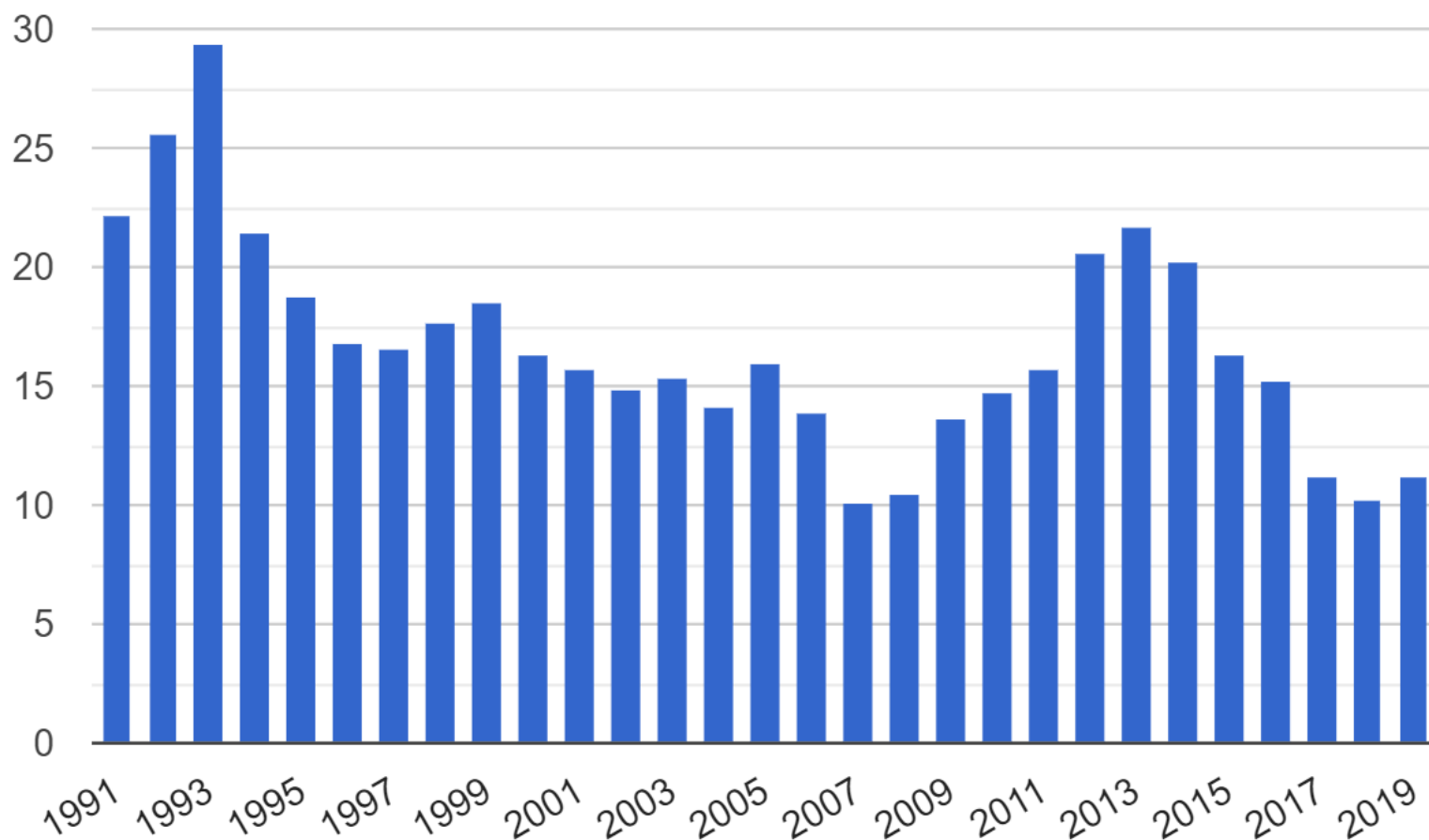
- The International Labor Organization (ILO) estimates that the **global youth unemployment rate is 13.1%** in 2016 (71 million young people) and remain at that level through to 2017 (up from 12.9% in 2015).
- **Youth Unemployment Rate in Slovenia** remained unchanged at 7.80 percent in September from 7.80 percent in August of 2019. Youth Unemployment Rate in Slovenia averaged **15.51 percent from 1996 until 2019**, reaching an **all time high of 25.50 percent in April of 2013** and a **record low of 6.60 percent in October of 2018**.

Here are solutions that try to tackle youth unemployment from a few different angles.

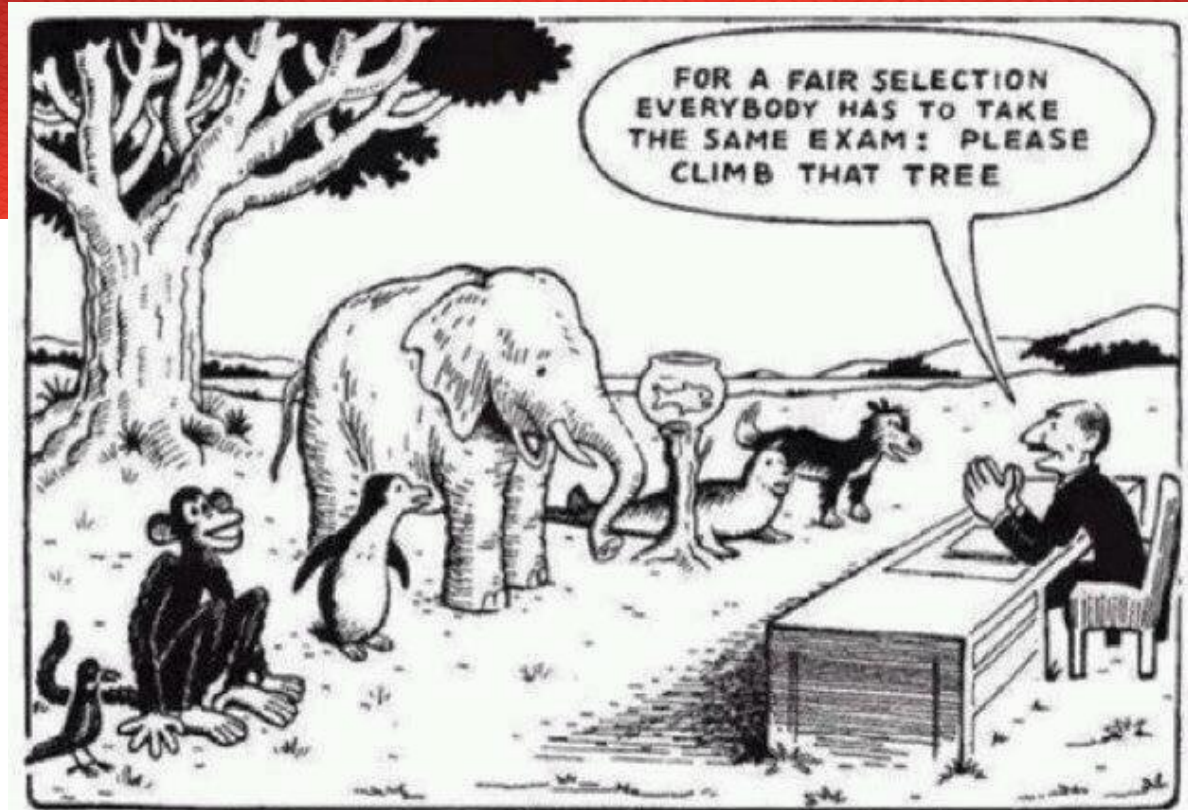
POSSIBLE SOLUTIONS

- **Implement Policies that Encourage Economic Growth**
 - **1. Lower taxes:** If you lower taxes they will be able to buy more and that will encourage job growth.
 - **2. Stop playing favorites:** The government needs to stop protecting rich and powerful industries at the expense of smaller endeavors.
 - **3. Stop putting money into unsustainable programs**
 - **4. Stop over-regulating industries:** Try starting your own business. It's really difficult to get anything off the ground due to the huge amounts of government regulations in many industries.



POSSIBLE SOLUTIONS

- **Change the Education System**
 - Instead of having to get an expensive bachelor's degree, **people should have more options to go to vocational school, or get a combination of liberal arts and then on-the-job training.**
 - Even better, it would be great to see **companies start adopting apprenticeship programs**, teaching young professionals what they need to know on the job.



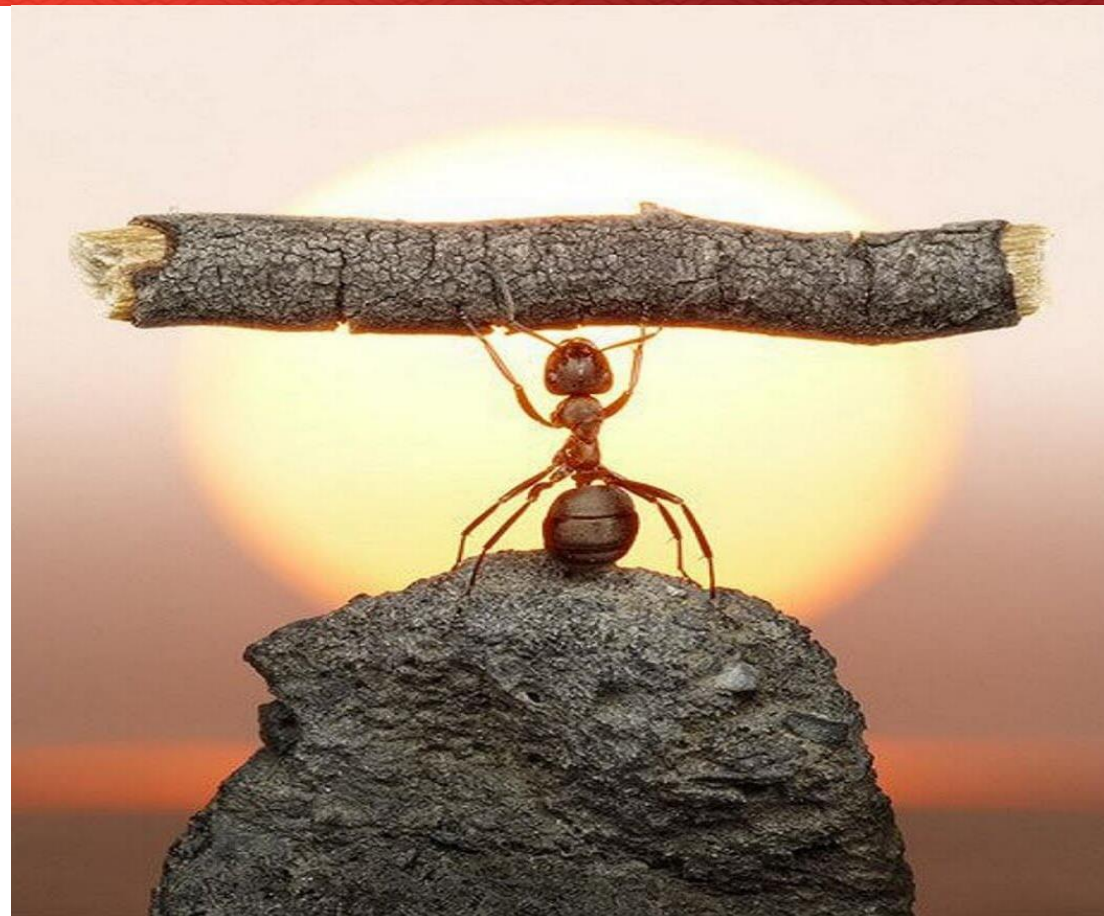
